[Sing for the Earth](#) brings the voice and interests of children to the United Nations and key capitals to influence the climate debate. Through a [1.5 Minute film](#), we call upon decision makers to fight climate change like their lives depend on it, because our children's lives do. Most climate negotiators and world leaders have children and realise that this year is the last chance to secure a safe climate future for them. We demonstrate that decisive action is in their personal and national interest, is justifiable and is necessary.

[The Sing for the Earth film](#) has already visibly touched the hearts and minds of high level decision makers at the UN, it was welcomed into the home of the UK Prime Minister and stimulated a Parliamentary Question in the House of Commons. Both the film and live Sing for the Earth events have caught the attention of the [media](#).

We have great ideas for adding impact and using this effective climate campaign tool;

- Re-cut the film with children from around the globe and print 1000 copies
- Exhibition of beautiful photos of children from around the world
- Children walk in silence into the negotiations and place an Earth with the meeting chair
- Children could parade with the flags of the UN Nations or sing at the opening ceremony.

### **Investing in the future – how you can be involved**

We invite you to invest in our children's future and help support this vital work. An initial fund of £1,000 is needed to bring this message from children to the UN climate talks in August.
